The chart positions cited are **Billboard** (with **Cashbox** listings in brackets). *Indicates picture sleeved singles and [Release Date]. MV = Music Vendor which became **Record World** (RW) in April, 1964, Chart positions are also given together with Billboard Disco or Adult Contemporary AC or R&B charts where applicable. Interesting related releases, demo/promo/DJ copies are also mentioned together with the odd track(s) on selected albums.

sleeved EP, because of VJ 576, peaked on the Billboard charts at no. **108** in 01/64, and on MV at 72!
