The discography listed below cites official, regular/stock (shop) copies of 4 Seasons' 45 rpm USA releases on vinyl, CD or musicassette with a mention of promo/demo copies of interest and also any other collectable interesting releases including albums around during this period.

The chart positions cited are BB = Billboard, CB = Cash Box, MV = Music Vendor, RW = Record World plus BB Adult Contemporary AC, BB R&B or BB Disco charts, RC = UK Record Collector.

*Indicates picture sleeved single, *ri* reissue, rev(s) - review(s) and any recommended/spotlight singles included as reviews, ad – advert, usually full page.

N.B. MV became RW in April, 1964. Actual release dates *where known* are given [in brackets] after the record label numbers plus known dates of any BB or CB reviews are all shown in order of *date/month/year*.

Interesting records and odd track(s) on selected albums are also mentioned. This discography may not be complete. September 2018
