Also a time when people had big hair and big glasses!

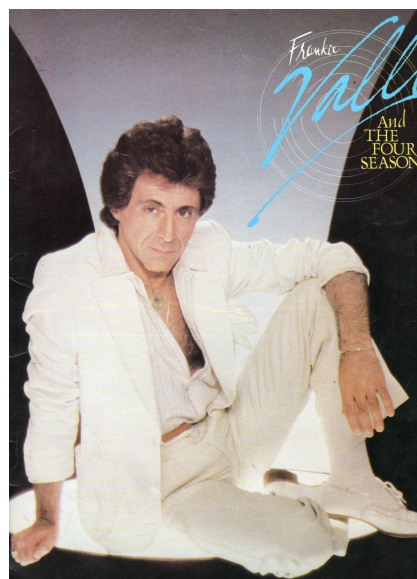
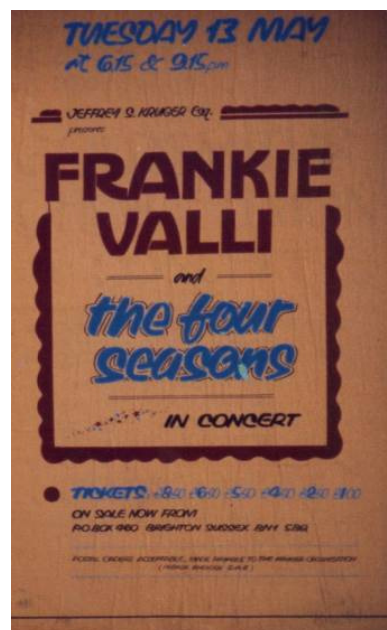

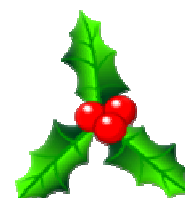
