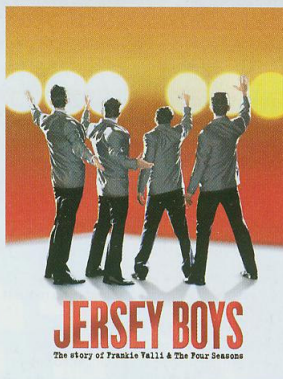
LHTS SELLING VALLI SHOW

But that all changed with a quartet of singers from Newark named Frankie Valli and The Four Seasons. Their music reached

millions and their story spanned decades.

Frankie Valli, Bob Gaudio, Tommy DeVito and Nick Massi perfected their style playing in Jersey Clubs like the Silhouette in Newark. They christened themselves The Four Seasons taking their new and final name from a bowling alley lounge in Union, N.J.

The whole world exploded with a little song whipped up in about 15 minutes. With its opening plunkety-plunk beat, tight harmonies and Frankie Valli's falsetto cry, 'Sherry' sailed to No 1 in the autumn of 1962.
