1960s hits with Phil Spector and Steve Tudanger was a member of the 4Evers

After You (Crewe/Corbetta/Marmelzat – Jerry Corbetta had performed with the group 'Sugarloaf' a Denver, Colorado based rock and roll band that performed from 1970 to 1975. Jerry teamed up with Bob Crewe in 1975 when he was the band leader of the The Jam Band on the Disco-Tex and The Sex-O-Lets first album...and became a four Season in 1979 until 1981)

Torn Between Two Lovers (Peter Yarrow/Philip Jarrell) A Nr 1 hit for Mary McGregor in 1976 – Was this the original?

Turn It All Around (Crewe/Hardwick)

What Love has Joined Together

Whatever you Want (Crewe/Gaudio)Originally recorded with Jerry Butler in 1962

When I Come Of Age

With You (Ken Ascher – Carole Bayer Sager) - later re-recorded and released on Private Stock PS7002

You Can't Hold On

Just A Little Girl (Goffin – King?)

My Eyes Adored You (Crewe – Nolan – reputed that 3 versions found on tape from late 1973 or early 1974 sessions – bought by Valli and re-recorded at Media Sound NYC and later released on Private Stock rising to Nr1 in the USA)
